

No sew DIY embossing pillow

This easy embossing pillow comes together quickly and easily with just a few supplies. Why do you need an embossing pillow? You can heat emboss without one, but using one will ensure that stray embossing powder doesn't make its way onto your project.

You'll need:

Baby powder, talc, or corn starch

A small piece of fabric (cotton, muslin, old t-shirt, sock, etc)

Rubber band

Lay the fabric flat, and place a little bit of powder in the centre. Bring up the corners and completely enclose the powder in the cloth.

Before stamping your project, rub the pillow all over the surface you are planning to stamp.
